Hold the Rope – The Resurrection

¹²Now if Christ is preached, that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? ¹³But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised; ¹⁴and if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain. ¹⁵Moreover we are even found *to be* false witnesses of God, because we testified against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised. ¹⁶For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised; ¹⁷and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. ¹⁸Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. ¹⁹If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied.

	"Now as they observed the confidence of Peter and John and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and <i>began</i> to recognize them as having been with Jesus" (Acts 4:13).

- The blood for the atonement of sin. Leviticus 17:11; Matthew 26:28

- The Messiah's suffering would include thirst. Psalm 22:15; John 19:28
